GENERAL INFORMATION

General

- These plans should be modified as you see fit and are meant to be a guide. All plans are just a sample of a trip that we took and can be expanded or contracted as your travel time allows.
- Taking a sleeper train was an amazing experience. They are a very time-effective and romantic way to travel.
- Forget the terms 'first class' & 'second class', with sleeper trains. On overnight trains, your comfort depends on whether you choose an ordinary seat, a couchette, or a comfortable berth in the sleeping-car.
- Incidentally, trains don't have sterns or bows, or port or starboard. They also don't have cabins, as they are not a ship. The correct term is sleeper or couchette compartment.

France

- We loved staying in the Bastille area of France. It was easy to get around Paris from this location as it was close to transportation and restaurants.
- We recommend Le Marceau Bastille. Great boutique hotel that included breakfast. Close to transit.
- Il Quadrifoglio had great gluten-free options for dinner. Awesome meal.

Portugal

- We did a local tour of Lisbon that our hotel recommended. I would recommend booking something in advance. All the tours we booked in advance were much better than that one.
- Drink the local wine in Portugal. It was amazing and cheaper than soda or bottled water in many restaurants.

Spain

- We bought 1st class tickets on the train. It is a long train ride and the 1st class ticket was worth the upgrade to our Eurail pass.
- Lounges are open to all 1st class ticket holders at the following stations: Madrid Atocha, Madrid Chamartin, Barcelona Sants, Malaga, Seville, Cordoba, Valencia, Alicante, Girona, Zaragoza and Valladolid stations. You can use them from 2 hours before your train leaves until departure. For details search www.renfe.com.
- Madrid Chamartin has luggage lockers open 07:00-23:00 daily. Small locker 3 euros, medium €3.50, large €5. The lockers are across the road from the main concourse. There's an X-ray check of all bags entering locker area.
- During our layover in Madrid we got an amazing Thai Massage.
